2. The first trustees of the trust shall be:

- II. Smt. Gargi Goel W/o Sri Kapil Goel, r/o Ward No. 9, Moh. Shivpuri, Post Babrala, Distt. Sambhal, UP 202421

3. The Trustee/Trustees shall have power to administer the funds of the trust and any power exercisable by the Board of Trustees as may be delegated to the Trustee/Trustees.
4. The Trustee/Trustees shall hold office for life or until he resigns there from.
5. The Trustee/Trustees during the lifetime shall name the successor to the Trustee/Trustees and on his failure to do so, his/her legal heir shall be appointed by the Board of Trustees.
6. The Trustee/Trustees shall have overall power of superintendence over the affairs of the Trust and shall have in particular, the power to operate the bank account, borrow money for the trust and carry out the objects of the trust.
7. **The objects of the trust are as under:**
 - (a) Educational – to run, maintain or assist any educational or other institution for coaching, guidance, counseling or vocational training including Nursing College or to grant individual scholarships for poor, deserving and needy students for elementary and higher education.
 - (b) Medical – to run, maintain or assist any medical institution, nursing home or clinics or to grant assistance

to needy and indigent persons for meeting the cost of medical treatment.

(c) Relief of the poor- to give financial or other assistance in kind by way of distribution of books, notebooks, clothes, uniforms, or meals for the poor and indigent.

(d) Other objects of general public utility –

(i) to acquire property for the sole use for public good by making it available for public purposes as for example, housing a library, clinic, crèche and/or as a community hall to be available for public use as training classes, seminars, discourses and other public functions for benefit of the community in general;

(ii) to undertake any other activity incidental to the above activities but which are not inconsistent with the above objects.

(iii) Research, education and training in Agriculture and allied fields including biotechnology.

(iv) To undertake and promote the publication & translation of journal, research papers and books and to develop the audiovisual programme to disseminate knowledge pertaining to the objectives of the trust.

(v) To promote literature, science, art, education and culture through promotion and protection of Indian Traditional music, dance, Art, modern art & literature, handicraft, handlooms, cottage industries, Khadi; traditional therapies like Yoga, Naturopathy, Meditation, Acupressure, Acupuncture, Massage Therapy, Ayurveda, Homeopathy, Reiki etc and traditional games along with the contemporary sports among youth & others.


(vi) To work for Human rights, welfare of Animals, global peace, and welfare and literacy of child, women, and weaker sections of the society through formation of self help groups etc.

(vii) To work for protection and conservation of Environmental, natural (land, water, energy etc.) and genetic resources.

- ii. Board of Trustees shall have the power to invest the funds in best possible manner with a view to augment the resources of the Trust to be able to better fulfill the objects of the Trust, but the Trust will not embark or any business or invest in any speculative venture. Such investments will also not deviate from the requirements of any law relating to public Trusts or law relating to exemptions under section 11 to 13 of the Income-tax Act for income-tax and other direct tax laws.
- iii. The Trustees will be entitled to accumulate the income of the objects of the Trust and to apply the same either out of the funds or the income for purposes of the Trust to the extent considered prudent and necessary during the year subject to any regulations governing such accumulation under any law for the time being on force.
- iv. Board of Trustees shall open and operate one or more bank accounts as may be authorized by resolution to be operated by the trust. The Board will have power to borrow, sign bills of exchange and cheques and authorities for this purpose any three of the Trustees or anyone of them along with Secretary or any other paid employee or nominee to exercise such power on its behalf by a Resolution.
- v. Board of Trustees shall have power to convert the trust property, acquire immovable property, sell, charge, rent out or otherwise alienate the assets including immovable property for protecting or improving the Trust property or for any object of the Trust.
- vi. Board of Trustees shall have power to use, defend suits and compromise them in the interest of the Trust in the name of the Trust.
- vii. Trustees will have power to engage, suspend or dismiss employees or to take such other action to ensure proper management. It will have all powers necessary and incidental for management and administration of the Trust and its properties.

- viii. Board of Trustees shall have the power to delegate their duties to any one of themselves or to employees, co-trustees and committees.
- ix. Board of Trustees may invite any employee, expert or well-wisher to attend Trust Board meeting for advice and participation without right to vote.
- x. All properties, whether movable or immovable, whether owned or entrusted to the Trust by any person or body for management will stand vested in the Trust will be subject to control and supervision of the Board.
- xi. The trustees shall have full power to give gifts in cash or to issue cheques/bank draft to outsiders out of the trust fund/capital.
- xii. The trustees shall have full power to utilize trust capital as they proper and they have fully entitled to give trust's capital as gifts to outsider whenever they deem fit.
- xiii. The trustees can receive or give gifts to other trust in cash, gold, bullion, precious stone etc.
- xiv. The trustees shall be free to invest all the monies which shall require investment in any manner they think fit and proper without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing provisions.
- xv. The trustees are hereby expressly authorized to accept gifts or money or movable or immovable property from the settler or any other person on such terms and conditions as may be deemed proper in their absolute discretion and any such gifts shall be held as an accretion to and argumentation to the trust fund and all the provisions contained in these presents shall be applicable thereto as if such money or property had formed part of the original trust fund.
- xvi. The trustees may open current or saving or fixed deposit bank account in their joint names or individual names or in the name of the trust as trustees or any trade name as proprietor/manager and may sign the cheques in their own names as proprietors/managers/trustees for the trust.





(xi) Other Incidental Powers:

- i. The trustees may invest the Trust funds either in immovable properties or in such manner as prescribed by these presents and as allowed by law as may be in force from time to time and to convert, alter, vary, dispose of or transfer such investments from time to time for better being able to conduct the affairs of the trust consistent with the objects of the trust.
- ii. If the income from the trust property in a particular year is not fully utilized, the unexpended income subject to the applicable provisions of the Income-tax Act, 1961 as may be amended from time to time or under any provision of Trust law or regulations governing such charitable institutions shall be carried over to the next year or years and spent in such subsequent year or years for the advancement of any of the object of the trust, the money meanwhile being invested in the manner required or permitted by the above said laws.
- iii. The trustees shall be at liberty to sell such portion or portions of the movable or immovable properties part of the Trust Estate either by public auction or by private contract at such price or prices and in such terms and conditions relating to title or otherwise in all respects as they may in their absolute discretion think fit and to rescind or vary any contract for the sale thereof and to resell the same and to execute all conveyance or other assurances and to pass valid and effectual receipts and discharges for all moneys received by them.
- iv. The trustees shall keep an account with any bank or banks, to operate such account or accounts whether in debit or in credit and to give all appropriate instructions to the banker or bankers concerning the operation of such account or accounts and to authorize by appropriate by appropriate direction or resolution of the trustees any one trustees or any one trustee





 - viii. The trustees may appoint, employ or engage secretaries, managers, accountants, lawyers or others for the purposes of management and supervision of the Trust Estate for collection of rents, effects and profits, for keeping the accounts and records and for other purposes of the trust.
